INTRODUCTION TO ROBOTICS

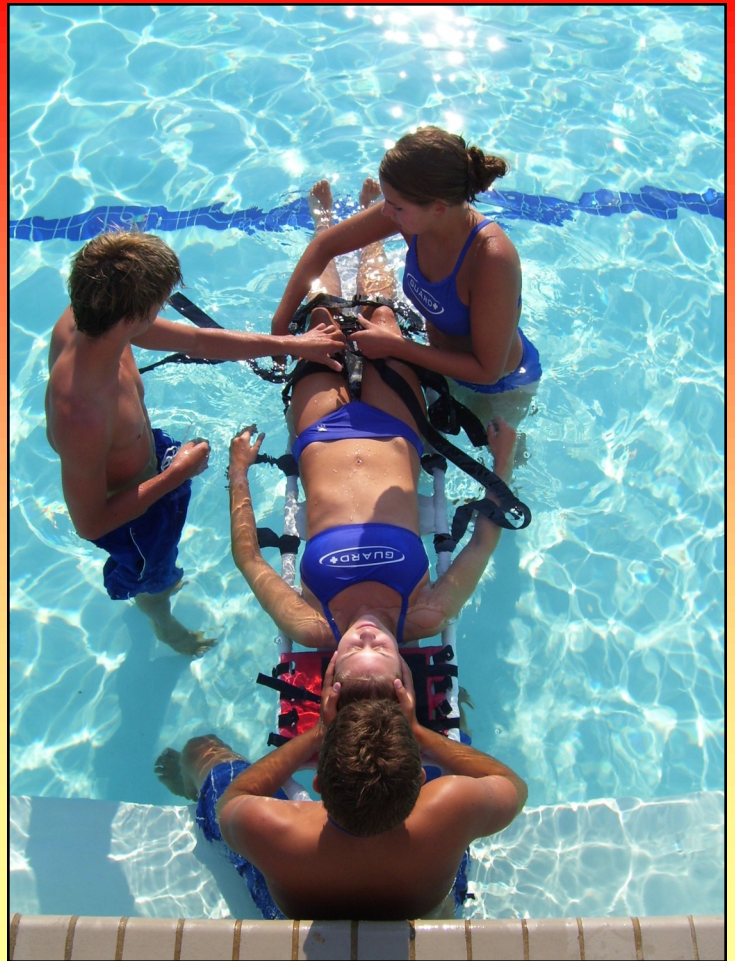
