



Beyond the Art Room

INDEPENDENT DIRECTED STUDY IN ART

Up to 4 Grade 11 or 12 credits

Do you have a passion for making art? Do you make a lot of art on your own time? Do you take art classes outside of school, or seek out online tutorials to inspire you and improve your skills? Would you like to get course credit for this, plus have an opportunity to work with a mentor to refine your skills, define your style, and figure out where to take your art next? Then this course is for you!

This Independent Directed Studies (IDS) course runs outside of the timetable. Students will develop an IDS plan with the supervising teacher and choose specific areas of focus. Students will be required to regularly submit work in progress for feedback and report on hours of work completed. Students must also be enrolled in regularly scheduled courses in Art and/or the Hackerspace.

Prior to being accepted into this IDS course, students will be required to:

- Submit samples of artwork (sketchbook, finished pieces and/or digital)
- Have an interview with the supervising teacher
