During this time, teachers run final assessments for their classes and attendance is vital. As we do not have regularly programmed classes, please check the online calendar for a detailed schedule:

Here are some general items to be aware of:

**Grade 10s** – Students who are currently in Math and or English class this semester are to write a Provincial Assessment with their class (in addition the final assessments for their other classes). Students who are taking Math and/or English next semester, will write the Provincial Assessment in April.

**Grade 11s** – Students will complete final assessments as arranged by individual teachers in their classes. See schedule. Students wishing to rewrite their Numeracy/Literacy assessments may schedule a time to do so with the main office.

**Grade 12s – Important! All grade 12s must write the provincial Numeracy Exam for graduation. Most students have done this in grade 10. However, if your student has not done so or would like to rewrite, they must arrange a time to write during Assessment Week. Check with the main office to schedule a time and place.**

We are working hard to support students as we come to the end of this semester.
