SCHOOL LOCKERS SEARCH POLICY

To All Students at Timberline Secondary School:

1. Timberline Secondary School provides school lockers for all students during the school year. You are not required to use a school locker. However, if you do use a school locker, you agree to keep only your personal belongings in the locker. You also agree not to keep anyone else's belongings in your locker.
2. You may use a school locker only if you agree to use a lock sanctioned by Timberline Secondary School that can be accessed by Administration.
3. You cannot keep any of the following in your school locker:
 - Drugs
 - Alcohol
 - Stolen Property
 - Anything that could be used as a weapon
 - Anything deemed by the school or police to be a danger to students
 - Anything that is illegal to possess

However, you are permitted to keep prescription drugs in your locker, if your doctor has prescribed those drugs for your personal use.

4. Even though students put locks on their school lockers, you do not have an expectation of privacy for your lockers. Lockers are the property of Timberline Secondary School. Timberline Secondary School has the right to open, search and inspect your school lockers without notice to you if Timberline Secondary School has reasonable grounds to believe that you have anything listed above in Section 3 in your locker.
5. If Timberline Secondary School searches your locker, and a teacher finds anything listed above in Section 3 in your locker, Timberline Secondary School may seize those items and use them as evidence against you for school discipline. Timberline Secondary School may give those seized items to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) for possible criminal investigations and charges.
6. Timberline Secondary School may invite the RCMP to visit Timberline Secondary School several times each year to search the locker areas and the outside of closed lockers with police dogs. These searches will ensure that none of the items listed above in Section 3 are in school lockers at any time. If the police dogs detect drugs or any other item listed above in Section 3 in your locker, Timberline Secondary School authorities and/or the RCMP may open and inspect your locker.
7. Timberline Secondary School will announce this School Lockers Policy to all students. Timberline Secondary School will post this School Lockers Policy in various places within the school. All Timberline Secondary School students will read and sign this page and then return the signed letter to their contact teacher. Parents and guardians of all students will receive a copy of this policy via the school newsletter.

I have read and understood the Timberline Secondary School Lockers Policy. I understand that I have no right to privacy for my school locker and the contents of my school locker. I agree to obey this School Lockers Search Policy.
